## Hedgehog Street: 33,000 Hedgehog Champions and counting...

Hedgehog Street is a campaign to encourage neighbours to work together to help hedgehogs in their neighbourhoods. It was launched in 2011, after research by People's Trust for Endangered Species and British Hedgehog Preservation Society showed a quarter of the UK's hedgehogs had been lost in just ten years. Close to home there are a range of reasons for this: impermeable fencing is a big issue, along with loss of habitat for nesting and foraging, the effects of certain hazards and certain garden practices.
